PgCert in Addictions

The Postgraduate Certificate in Addictions is designed to develop, enhance and refine students' knowledge and practical skills in the substance misuse field and examine this in relation to the underpinning of current practice



Who is the programme for?

The programme is for those who work in drug and alcohol related services in Scotland, from prevention and harm reduction to treatment. It is also relevant to a wide range of professionals, and to those who are interested in, and whose work brings them into contact with, drug and alcohol misusers.

What will I get from this programme?

By the end of the programme you will have developed:

- a critical awareness to assess the evidence base and research for interventions in the substance misuse field;
- a critical appraisal of contemporary knowledge and practice in the substance misuse field;
- a critical analysis of evidence based practice and national policy in regard to the substance misuse.

Programme structure

The certificate consists of three courses of study, each equivalent to 20 credits at Masters level.

Entry requirements

- a relevant degree in an appropriate discipline (i.e. nursing, social work) or;
- a relevant professional qualification, which should also be in an appropriate discipline or;
- at least five years experience of working with drug or alcohol misusers.

Applicants without relevant qualifications may be considered if they have a minimum of five years experience in the substance misuse field and can demonstrate an ability to study at postgraduate level.

In order to complete the programme students will usually need to be able to participate in direct work with drug and alcohol service consumers; although consideration will be given to applicants who are involved in commissioning and managing such services.
